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# GOVERNMENT STRATEGIC INITIATIVES (1 OF 3):

## Defense and security

Attracting additional funding from partners for weapons production and army supplies. At least 50% of funds for armaments are spent on the purchase of Ukrainian weapons. Transformation of the defense forces. A unified policy for the construction of fortifications and defensive structures, electronic warfare, and air defense. Scaling up domestic production based on the Danish model. Launch of Defense City and development of innovation. Improved conditions of service.

## Anti-corruption

We aim to establish transparent, fast, and secure interaction between the state, citizens, and businesses. To this end, we are introducing roadmaps with the EU. We are also adding new digital services — e-Notary, e-Court, and ASC 2.0 (Administrative Service Centre) — which reduce corruption and improve efficiency in interactions with the state.

## European integration

By the end of the year, we will complete all reviews of our legislation and will be ready to start negotiations on EU accession across all 6 clusters.

## Well-being

Recovery of frontline territories and support for internally displaced persons (IDPs) — a single intergovernmental programme of compensation for lost housing of IDPs whose property remains in temporarily occupied territories, risk insurance for businesses, support for farmers, and security infrastructure. Accumulation of at least UAH 25 billion for key community needs from various programmes in 2025 and over UAH 50 billion in 2026. A special economic regime in frontline regions: conditions for business and employment. Indexation and development of pension and social programmes.

# GOVERNMENT STRATEGIC INITIATIVES (2 OF 3):

## Veteran policy

Launch of a comprehensive veteran support programme: scaling up of veteran hubs, rehabilitation services, and financial assistance. Convenient services for service members and veterans in Diia.

## Business

Moratorium on business inspections (5 years), accelerated privatisation, incentives for production in Ukraine, private sector involvement in infrastructure and recovery, market opening and export, deregulation, investment funds (from the US and the EU).

## Macrofinance and reforms

\$37 billion in assistance for 2026–2027, expenditure audit, de-shadowing of the economy, new IMF programme. New Customs Code.

## Health and sport

Programme for early detection and prevention of non-communicable diseases. Medical infrastructure, rehabilitation, prosthetics, staffing and working conditions, including in rural areas and territories affected by hostilities. European sports model. Sports science. Youth policy. Strengthening identity.

# GOVERNMENT STRATEGIC INITIATIVES (3 OF 3):

## Education and science

Reform of teachers' salary, free school meals, high-quality and accessible in-person and distance learning, technologies for online education; reform of vocational education and science funding.

## Culture

Restoration and preservation of cultural heritage, institutionalisation of memory, stimulation of creative entrepreneurship and development of resilient cultural institutions.

## Recovery

Establishment of the Recovery Fund and a comprehensive Recovery Plan for Ukraine. Major infrastructure projects, housing reconstruction, restoration of logistics and infrastructure, the "comprehensive recovery" project, engagement with regions and each community. PIM and SPP. Special programmes to encourage Ukrainians to return — housing, employment, and social support. Launch of multiple citizenship.

Protection of critical infrastructure against drone and missile attacks. Energy and physical security for citizens and businesses. Guarantee of uninterrupted energy supply for citizens and businesses during the 2025/2026 heating season. Resilience of digital infrastructure.

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# PRIORITIES OF MINISTRIES



## THE MILITARY HAVE EVERYTHING THEY NEED TO DEFEND THE COUNTRY

Full support for the frontline, development of Ukraine's own defense industry, cooperation with partners, and new financial mechanisms.

- At least \$5 billion from partners for defence industry development in 2025, with a portfolio until 2026
- Funding until 2026 (+NATO contribution concept at 5%)
- 50% of procurement for the Armed Forces covered by domestic production
- We are merging the Defence Procurement Agency and the State Operator For Non-Lethal Acquisition (DOT), increasing decentralized procurement
- Implementation of a registry of arms and equipment manufacturers
- Preparation for signing the US-Ukraine Mega Deal & Drone Deal
- Development of a unified policy on fortifications and protective structures
- Development of policies on electronic warfare and air defense

## TECHNOLOGIES THAT GIVE YOU AN EDGE

Drones, AI, digital systems — for saving lives, ensure rapid response, and secure strategic advantage.

- Launch of Defence City — a special legal regime for privileges and financing for manufacturers
- Adoption of military and political decisions based on verified data
- Grant and incentive programs targeted at key challenges on the battlefield
- Independent, fast, high-quality, and accessible space intelligence for military units Focus on researching enemy innovations and predicting future challenges
- Opening military technologies to the private sector
- DOT.Chain: a platform for interaction with suppliers

## TRANSFORMATION OF DEFENSE FORCES

Clear structure, responsible management, support, and trust in the command.

- Completion of the transition to a modular system
- Creation and development of cyber forces
- Development of air force capabilities and creation of an integrated air and missile defense system
- Design of a new contract for military personnel, with improved service conditions
- Reserve+: Territorial Recruitment Centres services online
- Army+: services for military personnel in one app
- Digitalisation of defence resources: accounting for personnel, logistics, and finances.
- Transfer of state-owned enterprises under the Ministry of Defence and seized assets to efficient managers or the State Property Fund of Ukraine

## PROTECTION IN EVERYDAY LIFE

People should feel safe at home, outside, and on the road. The police work proactively, not only responding after the fact.

- Community police officers — a new type of district police officer in every neighborhood
- Community safety centers — police, State Emergency Service, and medical personnel in one building
- Development of the civil protection system — modernization of public alert systems, renovation of protective structures, strengthening of the State Emergency Service
- Humanitarian demining
- Street and park cameras — video surveillance to prevent crime
- Automatic recording of traffic violations — fines without bribes
- Fight against drug trafficking and internet fraud
- Strengthening the search for persons missing under special circumstances and identification of the bodies of the deceased

## DEVELOPMENT OF ONLINE SERVICES

What used to take weeks can now be done via smartphone or at the Centre for Administrative Services (CSC) 2.0. Fewer in-person interactions mean less corruption.

- Services of the Ministry of Internal Affairs and the State Migration Service — digital and available through CSCs





# MINISTRY OF DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION

## DIGITAL EDUCATION AND SERVICES FOR CITIZENS

Expanding services so that digital tools become as familiar and reliable way for citizens to access public services as visiting an institution in person, but faster and more convenient.

- "Mriya" for schools — a unified education management platform (30–100% of schools)
- New services for citizens — social protection, healthcare, taxes, support for veterans, businesses, drivers; Centre for Administrative Services (CSC) 2.0
- Services for military personnel and veterans on the Diia Portal

## EU INTEGRATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

Technological and regulatory alignment with the European digital space, expansion of connectivity.

- Integration into the Single Digital Market — EUDI Wallet, Ukrainian QES recognised in the EU
- Connectivity and infrastructure — 5G pilot, Direct-to-Cell, single roaming zone with the EU, internet on railways, infrastructure resilience

## TRANSPARENCY, CONTROL, AND ANTI-CORRUPTION

Technologies ensure openness of processes and control at every stage. This reduces corruption risks, builds trust, and enables prompt response to abuses.

- Digitalization to fight corruption — e-Notary, electronic court, online monitoring of gambling licenses
- Digitization of services and control procedures for business, e-Excise

## INNOVATION AND GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY

Implementation of solutions that accelerate the work of the government, support the economy and defence, and create conditions for the development of dual-use technologies

- Innovative economy — development of dual-use technologies
- Efficiency of public services — government optimization, Diia.Office



# VPM FOR EUROPEAN AND EURO-ATLANTIC INTEGRATION

## SYNCHRONIZATION WITH THE EU

European integration is a concrete action plan to create new opportunities for Ukrainian businesses, citizens, and the economy. We are opening the door to European markets, standards, and investments

- Readiness for EU accession negotiations on all six clusters by the end of 2025
- Dialogue with NATO
- Progress under the Enlargement Package — positive European Commission Report
- Launch of negotiations with the ACAA — adoption of two key draft laws
- Liberalisation of markets with the EU
- National program for the implementation of the *acquis* — plan for the implementation of all EU acts
- Formulation of a negotiating position on critical economic issues
- Deregulation upon EU accession — formation of a negotiating position enabling the implementation of deregulation initiatives
- Approval of a CBAM exemption for Ukraine to stimulate the economy
- Transformation of intergovernmental commissions into commissions on reconstruction and holding at least five commissions with key European countries

## FIGHT AGAINST CORRUPTION

Fair justice, equitable public administration, and reliable protection of citizens' rights.

- Implementation of the Roadmap on the Rule of Law
- Implementation of the Roadmap on the functioning of democratic institutions
- Implementation of the Roadmap on Public Administration Reform
- Implementation of the Action Plan for the Protection of the Rights of Persons Belonging to National Minorities (Communities) of Ukraine

## INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC INTEGRATION

Access to new markets, integration of the economy into global value chains through partnerships with leading countries.

- Obtaining a roadmap for Ukraine's accession to the OECD
- Opening of FTAs with partner countries — ratification with the UAE and Turkey
- Launch of FTA negotiations with the Balkan and North African countries
- Signing of an investment protection agreement with Japan



## CHILD-FRIENDLY JUSTICE AND ACCESS TO LEGAL AID

Building an infrastructure for child protection and stable mechanisms for engaging specialists.

- "Barnahus": a network in 15 regions
- Involvement of psychologists in criminal proceedings involving children
- Mediation in cases involving juvenile offenders (restorative justice)
- Verification of data on deported and forcibly displaced children with a view to their return and bringing the aggressor to justice
- Expanding access to legal aid in frontline territories
- Draft law on juvenile justice

## DIGITAL JUSTICE AND CYBER SECURITY

Digitizing key services and protecting registries to ensure fast and secure services.

- Civil Status Registration Reform: e-services and simplification of procedures
- e-Notary. Launch of system components
- Digitization of enforcement proceedings Cybersecurity of digital infrastructure in the justice sector

## MODERNIZATION OF THE PENITENTIARY SYSTEM

Improving the effectiveness of criminal punishment and ensuring the resocialization of convicts.

- International standards of detention
- Start of construction of a new pre-trial detention center
- Introduction of a pilot project to integrate prison medicine into a single medical space
- Creation of a modern legal framework for regulating the activities of the penitentiary system

## PROTECTION OF PROPERTY, SANCTIONS, AND INTERNATIONAL RESPONSIBILITY

We guarantee the security of property rights, fight against raiding, and bring aggressors to justice.

- Anti-raider measures and improving the security of the property register
- Confiscation of assets of sanctioned persons for the benefit of the state. Standardization of liability for sanctions violations
- Support for the establishment of a Special Tribunal for the Crime of Aggression



# MINISTRY FOR DEVELOPMENT (1 of 2):

## RECONSTRUCTION OF REGIONS AND SUPPORT FOR FRONT-LINE TERRITORIES

People are returning to their restored homes, and those who remain in frontline regions are receiving the support they need to live and work normally.

- Comprehensive reconstruction of settlements
- Compensation for housing to owners in temporarily occupied territories
- Comprehensive support for frontline territories — from infrastructure to social services
- Establishment of a special regime for frontline territories
- Energy-efficient restoration of residential buildings

## ATTRACTING INVESTMENT FOR RECOVERY

Ukraine receives significant international resources for rapid recovery, and business becomes an active partner in rebuilding the country.

- Creation of a Recovery Fund
- New G2G agreements for the reconstruction of Ukraine
- Attracting foreign investment for the recovery and development of Ukraine by 2025 in the amount of at least US\$1.5 billion
- Preparation of new public-private partnership projects in the field of infrastructure and water supply
- Establishment of a business coordination council for the reconstruction of Ukraine

## TERRITORIAL COHESION

Communities gain more opportunities for development and cooperation, resolve local issues more effectively, and prepare for EU accession and participation in European programs.

- Supervision of the legality of local government acts and the division of powers within the framework of decentralization reform
- Expansion of horizontal links between communities through the national project "Side by Side"
- Support for communities through the State Regional Development Fund, the Ukraine Recovery Programme, and additional funding for frontline communities
- Bringing regional policy closer to EU cohesion standards through strategic planning reform and preparation for the use of European Structural Funds



# MINISTRY FOR DEVELOPMENT (2 of 2):

## SUPPLY CHAIN SECURITY

Goods cross borders faster and Ukrainian grain reliably reaches world markets.

- Increasing border capacity — increased by at least 15% for freight and passenger transport
- Ensuring the sustainable functioning of Ukraine's "grain corridor"

## INFRASTRUCTURE FOR DEVELOPMENT

We are creating modern infrastructure for comfortable living and effective business.

- Modern border infrastructure for integration with the EU
- Investment and infrastructure reform of water supply and sanitation
- Energy efficiency of educational institutions and development of heat supply
- Deregulation of construction — updated building codes and simplified procedures
- Attracting international financial, technical, and political support
- Development of local government capacity

## MODERN TRANSPORT AND LOGISTICS

We are modernizing the transport system in line with European standards for safe and efficient transportation.

- Strengthening the Recovery Agency as a center of expertise
- Financial stability of Ukrzaliznytsia as a critically important carrier
- European standards of interoperability and safety in rail transport
- Public-private partnership in the seaport of Chornomorsk
- Reform of road transport in line with European safety standards
- Completion of the construction of the Eurostandard railway track between Chop and Uzhhorod
- Introduction of a Single Window for Maritime Transport in Ukrainian seaports



## NEW PENSION SYSTEM

We are creating a fair and sustainable pension system that guarantees a dignified old age for every Ukrainian.

- Guaranteed social payment upon reaching retirement age for all
- Variable pension component based on the amount of social security contributions
- Transformation of special pensions into professional pensions according to transparent rules
- Introduction of a mandatory accumulation system with international partners
- Proper protection of the state's interests in court cases on pension issues

## FIGHT AGAINST POVERTY AND NEW SOCIAL STANDARDS

We are updating the social protection system in line with European standards and the real needs of people.

- Basic social assistance taking into account family composition and real needs
- Reform of the minimum subsistence level in line with EU standards
- Social Code of Ukraine — updating the social contract

## SPECIAL SUPPORT PROGRAMS

We are launching targeted initiatives to return Ukrainians and support the most vulnerable territories.

- Program to return Ukrainians home — encouraging repatriation
- Additional measures to support the population of frontline territories



## TARGETED SUPPORT BASED ON NEEDS

We are moving from status-based support to assistance based on the real needs of a particular person.

- "Money follows the person" — a new system for financing social services
- Electronic case management and digitization of social services
- Creation of a competitive market for social services with the private and public sectors
- Unification and centralization of payments, elimination of outdated small payments

## SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN AND PROTECTION OF CHILDREN'S RIGHTS

We are encouraging the birth rate and ensuring every child's right to grow up in a family environment.

- Increased childbirth benefits, Baby Package, eNursery, School Package
- Expansion of children's access to social services (early intervention, care, development)
- Creating conditions for combining parenthood with professional activity
- Development of alternative forms of family-based upbringing
- Improvement of adoption procedures

## INCLUSION AND SUPPORT FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

Developing prosthetics and digitalising services.

- Establishment of a comprehensive prosthetics system
- Reforming disability benefits in line with the ICF and supporting employment

## THE PATH OF IDPs — SUPPORT FROM EVACUATION TO INTEGRATION INTO THE COMMUNITY

We are creating conditions for the social adaptation and economic independence of IDPs

- Creation of a "single window" for obtaining necessary services
- Introducing a general concept of the "IDP path"

The families of fallen heroes receive dignified places to honor their memory, and society preserves the history of the heroic deeds of every defender of Ukraine.

- We are introducing a system of memorialization and dignified burial sites for the fallen



## MACROFINANCIAL STABILITY AND EXTERNAL FINANCING

We ensure a balanced budget and provide revenues for key needs – from defence to social payments. We meet our commitments to international partners in order to secure long-term concessional financing and maintain trust in Ukraine as a reliable borrower. At the same time, we are introducing a new system of public investment planning so that funds are directed into projects with the greatest economic and social impact.

- Budget for 2026

- Search for additional sources of funding

## TAX POLICY

We are modernizing the tax system, making it understandable, competitive, and integrated with international standards. This will reduce the shadow economy, attract investment, and support business.

## PUBLIC DEBT MANAGEMENT

We are developing a transparent and predictable policy for working with public debt in order to reduce risks to the economy and lower the cost of servicing debt.

We are increasing economic transparency and trust in business through modern reporting and auditing standards, including sustainability reporting.

## DIGITALISATION OF FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

We consolidate all public finance data into a single system and transfer it to the cloud to make management fast, transparent, and secure.

## FINANCIAL MONITORING AND SECURITY OF THE FINANCIAL SYSTEM

We will harmonize financial legislation with EU and FATF requirements to protect the economy from money laundering, terrorist financing, and other threats.

## REDUCING THE ROLE OF THE STATE IN BANKS

Reducing the state's share in the banking sector to make it more competitive and customer-oriented.

# MINISTRY OF ECONOMY, ENVIRONMENT AND AGRICULTURE (1 of 3):

## PRIVATE SECTOR – DRIVER OF ECONOMIC GROWTH. A SET OF TOOLS FOR BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT AND SCALING UP

SME development, EU-compliant level playing field, tax incentives, capital expenditure compensation, processing support, mortgages, localization incentives, industrial parks, agricultural support, and demining.

- Start of accelerated privatization of state property and shares in state-owned enterprises
- Special conditions for businesses in frontline regions, new support programs "Made in Ukraine," compensation for capital investments through tax breaks
- Expansion of affordable mortgage programs "єОселя" (eOselya)

## CURRENT INDUSTRIAL POLICY

Restoration, modernization, and development of production, processing, the agricultural sector, and dual-use goods.

# MINISTRY OF ECONOMY, ENVIRONMENT AND AGRICULTURE (2 of 3):

## INVESTMENT IN PEOPLE AND PRODUCTIVITY

Ukrainians have the relevant knowledge, skills, ideas, and technologies to create high-quality products and high added value, which will ensure business growth, higher profits, and decent and competitive wages.

- New Labor Code
- Employment strategy until 2030
- Launch of Obriy as a digital ecosystem for the labor market

## DEREGULATION AND RISK-BASED INSPECTIONS

Simplification of regulations, digitization of procedures, elimination of duplication, introduction of the declarative principle.

- Risk-based approach to inspections
- Digitalization ("Pulse" and launch of "ePermit")
- Optimization of processes for obtaining environmental permits
- New wave of deregulation

## GROWTH INVESTMENT

Single window for investors, PPPs, reconstruction funds, war risk insurance, development of the UIF.

- Launch of investment funds (US and EU)
- Relaunch of Ukraine Invest
- Adoption of the FDI strategy until 2030
- Completion of PPP reform
- Attracting private capital for reconstruction (priority PPP projects and expansion of the "significant investments" program)
- Insurance of war risks
- Intergovernmental financing of recovery projects



# MINISTRY OF ECONOMY, ENVIRONMENT AND AGRICULTURE (3 of 3):

## ACTIVE EXPORT AND INTEGRATION INTO GLOBAL MARKETS

Growth in exports of high value-added products, including defense and dual-use products; favorable regulation; support for innovation; new financial instruments; integration into global supply chains; improving the competitiveness of Ukrainian goods and services.

- "Industrial visa-free regime"
- Export strategy until 2030
- Development of agricultural hubs to promote Ukrainian products abroad
- Expanding the capabilities of the Export-Credit Agency (guarantees and simplification of currency control)
- Simplification of export controls on strategic goods

## EUROPEAN INTEGRATION

Full implementation of European rules in key sectors of the economy — from industry, agricultural development, and farming to environmental protection; transparent, environmentally responsible, modernized, and harmonized with the EU acquis conditions for business development and access to the EU market.

- Passing the screening of chapters 11, 12, and 13
- Ukraine's negotiating positions taking into account the interests of Ukrainians and Ukrainian businesses (free movement of goods, state aid, competition policy, environmental protection and intellectual property rights; agricultural policy, food safety and sanitary and phytosanitary measures, fisheries and aquaculture)
- Implementation of Ukraine's Plan
- Launch of an agricultural support system in line with European standards



## QUALITY AND ACCESSIBLE MEDICAL CARE

Healthcare should work in such a way that both doctors and patients feel supported by the system.

- Revision of approaches to remuneration for family doctors and emergency medical personnel
- Launch of an e-patient account
- Implementation of unified standards of quality of treatment and a new approach to emergency care
- Free check-ups for patients at high risk of disease
- Accessible medicines: centralized procurement reduces corruption risks and ensures equal access
- E-license for medical practice
- New free medical services, including cardiac surgery and planned free stenting
- "Housing for doctors" and other incentives to address staff shortages in rural areas

## SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN: FROM NURSERY TO SCHOOL

We provide assistance by making childcare and education easier.

- Vaccination calendar updated, pediatric rehabilitation available closer to home

## VETERANS – SUPPORT IN ALL AREAS OF LIFE

Extended medical support for veterans.

- Expanded National Health Service of Ukraine (NHSU) packages, mental health support, and prosthetics are part of the standard route
- Reintegration of combat medics after demobilization — an opportunity to apply their experience and skills in civilian hospitals

## DEVELOPMENT AND RESTORATION OF MEDICAL INFRASTRUCTURE

Transformation and modernization of hospitals even in wartime.

## SERVICES FOR COMMUNITIES NEAR THE FRONT LINE - CLOSE TO HOME

People receive medical care where they live, without having to travel long distances.

Assistance is linked to functioning, not to stamps.

We help parents care for their children and provide access to quality education. Schools are becoming safe and digital.

- Schools have shelters and buses for transportation

- Updating the content of preschool education in line with the European Quality Framework for Education
- Updating the content of school education with a focus on STEM
- Schools near the front lines receive priority funding for food and transportation

This is a comprehensive effort that combines political, economic, and public instruments.

## PREPARATION FOR THE WINTER HEATING SEASON
